Auditions:

There are roles in this play for 60 local 1st through 8th grade students. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play. Students wishing to audition should arrive by the scheduled starting time and plan to stay for the entire two-hour session. The first rehearsal begins approximately 30 minutes after the auditions. This is a group audition with no advance preparation necessary – but a SMILE never hurts. Students should just come ready to have a good time! Participation Fee: \$25 if cast.

Rehearsals:

- Monday, March 21, 6:30PM-8:30PM
- Tuesday, March 22 Thursday, March 24 4PM-8:30PM
- Friday, March 25 8:30AM-NOON

Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the auditions. Cast members scheduled for a full $4\frac{1}{2}$ hour rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack lunch, supper or snack.

- Friday, March 25: 7 PM Public Performance
- Saturday, March 26: 2 PM Public Performance

All performances will be at the PAC. All those cast must be available for all scheduled performances.
