

About PAC Pro-Am Auditions

- Audition Materials: All Audition materials are available through ThePAC.net at least two weeks before In-Person Auditions occur.
 - Audition Form:
 - To be considered for casting, all Auditionees must submit the Online Audition Form.
 - Indicate two roles from both productions for which you'd like to audition.
 - Although computer kiosks will be available in the PAC lobby one hour before In-Person Auditions, Auditionees are strongly encouraged to submit their Audition Form online BEFORE arrival.
 - Audition Selections:
 - Audition Selections will be available online and through the Online Audition Form.
 - Auditionees should use the Character Descriptions provided to determine which roles best suit them.
 - Review Audition Selections before arrival and perform them with clear, bold acting choices and powerful vocals.
 - Audition Selections need not be memorized, but it is best to be as familiar with them as possible.
 - The performance of unsolicited extraneous monologues or songs will not be permitted. Casting will be based upon Auditionees performance of the Audition Selections provided.
- Casting:
 - Any pre-cast roles will be announced before Auditions. All other roles are open to both professionals and amateurs.
 - Although used as a guide, the Director reserves the right to deviate from Character Descriptions when casting.
 - If In-Person Audition turnout is high, the Director reserves the right to "type out" Auditionees based upon perceived or and/or demonstrated ability. Sexual orientation or race, either actual or perceived, will never be used to "type out" Auditionees.
- In-Person Auditions:
 - Annual In-Person Auditions occur mid-July over 2-3 days.
 - Auditionees should attend only one In-Person audition session for each production being cast.
 - If unable to attend In-Person Auditions, an Auditionee may submit a Video Audition (see below).
 - Auditionees should come prepared to audition for the roles they requested on their Audition Form.
 - Unless indicated otherwise on their Audition Form, Auditionees will be considered for all roles.
 - Regardless of the roles requested, Auditionees may be asked to audition for additional roles.
- Video Auditions:
 - If unable to attend In-Person Auditions, Auditionees may submit a Video Audition when submitting their Online Audition Form.
 - After posting your Video Audition on YouTube.com, copy and paste its link in the provided space on your Audition Form. Video Auditions will only be accepted via this submission method.
 - Your Audition Form (with a link to your video) must be submitted no later than one week before the scheduled In-Person Auditions.
 - If singing, Auditionees submitting a video are strongly encourage to use musical accompaniment.
