Auditions: There are roles in this play for up to 60 local 1st through 8th grade students. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play. Students wishing to audition should arrive by the scheduled starting time and plan to stay for the entire two-hour session. The first rehearsal begins approximately 30 minutes after the auditions. This is a group audition with no advance preparation necessary – but a SMILE never hurts. Students should just come ready to have a good time!
